Subj: RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PROCUREMENT, OPERATION AND
MAINTENANCE OF THE STATION FIRE ALARM/DETECTION SYSTEM

1. Purpose. To publish information and assign responsibility concerning procurement, operation and maintenance of the Fire Alarm/Detection System aboard this Station.
2. Cancellation. StaO 11320.12C.
3. Background. The Station Fire Alarm/Detection System is comprised of the Kingfisher smoke detection and fire alarm system. To ensure the system is fully effective and operational at all times, the Provost Marshal Office (PMO), Facilities Management Department (FMD) and Communication Data Electronics (CDE) Department must closely coordinate all actions impacting this system.
4. Action
 - a. Provost Marshal Office. The Station Fire Department will:
 - (1) Determine operational fire alarm requirements for all structures aboard this Station and submit deficiencies to the CDE Department.
 - (2) Conduct operational checks of the Station fire alarm system as required to ensure optimum operability and report discrepancies to the CDE Department.
 - (3) Notify the CDE Department at extension 2389 of all confirmed component/system outages.
 - b. Facilities Management Department. The Facilities Management Department will:

(1) Review all requests for changes/additions to the current Station fire alarm system and conduct/coordinate all feasibility studies with input from CDE as deemed necessary prior to submission to the Station Planning Board.

(2) Coordinate all proposed changes/additions to the Station fire alarm system with PMO and CDE Department.

(3) Prior to final project approval, provide the CDE Department with a wiring diagram of each scheduled facility to be outfitted with a fire alarm/detection devices.

(4) Provide the CDE Department with all electrical circuit paths from the Fire Alarm Control Panel to each local area interface panel and call box.

(5) Provide funding to the CDE Department for Maintenance/repair parts.

c. Communication Data Electronics Department. The Communication Data Electronics Department will:

(1) Maintain and repair all electronic hardware/components associated with the Station fire alarm system except those components covered by the fire sprinkler maintenance contract.

(2) Retain on file all manufacturers' information on current fire alarm systems that are in use aboard this Station.

(3) Replace equipment/components as they become obsolete or cost prohibitive to maintain.

5. Summary of Revision. This revision contains a substantial number of changes in paragraph 4.
