1. Purpose. To publish subject contract.
2. Cancellation. StaO 12711.2A
3. Background. This contract establishes mutual understanding relative to certain personnel policies, practices and procedures and other matters affecting the conditions of employment of Nonappropriated Fund bargaining unit employees. It is a workable agreement negotiated under the provisions of the reference, and was approved by the Secretary of Defense on 9 March 2001.
4. Information. The NAFI Personnel Office, 269-5759 is the Point of Contact for labor relations' matters. Questions on contract interpretation, or inclusion of positions in the bargaining unit are to be referred to the POC for guidance. Division/Branch/Section Heads must coordinate any changes in current directives and policies, which affect working conditions of Nonappropriated Fund Employees in the bargaining unit, with the POC to ensure that labor relations obligations are met.
5. Action. All military and civilian managers and supervisors responsible for the formulation of policies and procedures or for the direct or indirect supervision of Nonappropriated Fund Personnel are directed to review and apply the contents of this contract, encl(1).
