(b) Oil/Hazardous Substances Spill Contingency Plan

1. Purpose. To implement an updated spill contingency plan for the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Yuma and its tenants.

2. Cancellation. StaO 6280.6

3. Information. Reference (a) established the Marine Corps Hazardous Waste Environmental Management Program and specifically requires Marine Shore activities to provide a contingency plan that establishes policy, responsibilities, and procedures for the control and clean-up of hazardous substances spills within Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Yuma's jurisdiction. Reference (b) assigns responsibility for all MCAS Yuma personnel and provides instructions for appropriate hazardous material/waste spill prevention and a contingency plan to ensure conformance with the Environmental Protection Agency and Arizona hazardous waste regulations.

4. Action. All Commands/Departments at MCAS Yuma shall ensure that their personnel are aware of the requirements of the Oil/Hazardous Substances Spill Contingency Plan and shall personally support and implement appropriate policies and procedures.
