Subj: TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVE AND OTHER DANGEROUS MATERIALS

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Order is to establish safe and proper procedures for the transportation, receiving and shipping of ammunition, explosives and other dangerous materials per references (a) through (i).

2. Cancellation. StaO 8023.1K

3. Action

a. The Station Weapons Division will be responsible for:

(1) Mechanical inspection and removal of seals from commercial transporters delivering explosive shipments to the Air Station.

(2) The off-loading of commercial/military shipments consigned to Station Weapons.

(3) The proper classification, packaging and loading of outgoing commercial explosive shipments.

(4) Inspection of incoming explosive-laden transporters for shortage or damage to cargo.

b. The Traffic Management Office (TMO) will be responsible for:

(1) The mechanical inspection of commercial transporters prior to the loading of explosives by the Station Weapons Shipping and Receiving Section.

(2) Ensuring the compatibility of outgoing explosives in accordance with reference (i) and the proper blocking, bracing and sealing of shipments.

c. Transportation of explosives by government vehicle will be accomplished in the following manner:

(1) Drivers transporting explosives will be licensed and have in their possession all documents required by reference (c).

(a) Valid state drivers license.

(b) Valid U.S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator identification card (Standard Form 46 or Optional Form 346) on which "EXPLOSIVE DRIVER" has been stamped.

(c) Current medical certificate required by reference (a).

1 Military - Shall be renewed every 5 years until age 50, then every 2 years until age 60 then every year.

2 Civilian Personnel - Shall be renewed every 2 years until age 60 then annually.

(d) Completed Forms 626 and 836 as required by references (b) and (c).

(2) All vehicles transporting explosives on Station will be properly placarded per references (a), (b), and (d). Except when using the CALA explosive route to and from the Station Ordnance compound no placards are required.

(3) The maximum number of trailers loaded/unloaded that will be towed by one vehicle is two. The authorized load capacity of each trailer or vehicle will not be exceeded.

(4) All loads will be properly loaded per references (a) thru (f) prior to the movement of any vehicle. One person will always accompany the driver to watch for loosening or shifting of the load and any other malfunctions of vehicles or trailers that might endanger/damage either material or personnel.

(5) The maximum speed limit aboard the Air Station when transporting explosives or towing trailers loaded with explosives, is 15 MPH unless a lower speed is designated for a specific area. Curves or corners will be negotiated at a lesser speed commensurate with the road and load.

(6) The primary route for transporting explosives to and from the Station Ordnance Magazine Area will be via the Combat Aircraft Loading Area (CALA) gate. The secondary route will be via the Station Ordnance gate (Post #2) utilizing Frazier Ave. and either Hamilton St or Parks Ave. No explosives will be transported beyond the Parks Ave turn off on Frazier Ave.

(7) Vehicles transporting to or from the Air Station will enter and depart the main gate of the Station Ordnance Compound located on County 13th St. (Post #1).

d. Explosives laden commercial vehicles will be handled per references (a), (b) and (c) as outlined below.

(1) All explosives laden commercial vehicles will have access to Marine Corps Air Station, Yuma, for authorized overnight enroute stop or in any emergencies or disaster. The driver must have in his possession proper identification, such as a Government bill of lading (GBL) or shipping documents, prior to enroute stop being authorized per references (a), (b), (c) and (h).

(2) Completed forms 626 and 836 as required by references (b) and (c).

(3) Explosives laden vehicles with cargo consigned to Marine Corps Air Station, Yuma, arriving after normal working hours will be parked per references (a) and (b).

(4) The Station Ordnance Division will render all assistance required in compliance with this Order and may be reached at COMM (602) 341-2219/2127 or DSN 951-2219/2127.

4. Concurrence. The Commanding Officer MAG-13, 1st LAAM BN., MACS-7 MAWTS-1, CSSD-16 and VMFT-401 concur in and make this directive applicable to their respective Commands.
