Subj: Amateur/Citizens Band Operations Aboard MCAS Yuma

1. Purpose. To publish policies and instructions governing amateur and/or citizens band radio operations aboard this Station.

2. Cancellation. StaO 2374.1D.

3. Policy. It is the policy of the Department of the Navy (DON), CMC and the Commanding Officer, MCAS Yuma to encourage and support amateur/citizens band radio activities. The instructions contained here are intended to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the DON. The Commanding Officer, MCAS Yuma may regulate the time during which an amateur radio may be operated and may revoke an operator's authority to operate a citizens band radio station at MCAS Yuma. The Communication Data Electronics Officer is charged with the responsibility to supervise amateur/citizens band radio operations aboard MCAS Yuma and ensure that regulations set forth in this Order and FCC regulations are strictly enforced.

4. Action

a. Written permission must be obtained from the Commanding Officer, MCAS Yuma before any amateur/citizens band radio operations may be conducted aboard this Station. The applicant must submit a written request utilizing the format contained in enclosures (1) or (2) as applicable. Radio operation may not begin until the individual has received a written approval endorsement to the application signed by the Commanding Officer, MCAS Yuma.

b. An applicant seeking permission to operate a mobile radio unit only aboard this Station will submit an application utilizing the format contained in enclosure (1). The maximum height of the mobile unit antenna may not exceed 14' 8" as measured from the surface of the road.

c. An applicant seeking permission to operate a mobile radio unit and a base station radio unit from government quarters aboard this Station will submit an application utilizing the

format contained in enclosure (2). The following antenna restrictions will be adhered to when operating a base station radio unit aboard this Station:

(1) External antennas will be installed no closer than twice the antenna height from the nearest existing power line.

(2) The height of an external antenna will not exceed 1 foot of height per 100 feet of the distance from the closest point of the station runway. If there is an existing structure/obstacle such as a building, tree, etc. between the antenna location and the station runway, then the antenna may be as high as 20 feet above the structure/obstacle.

(3) Any damage to government quarters resulting from the collapse of the external antenna will become the financial responsibility of the applicant.

(4) All external antennas will be removed prior to vacating government quarters.

d. After permission has been granted for amateur/citizens band radio operations aboard this Station, it becomes the applicant's responsibility to effect harmonic suppression which will aid in the elimination of television interference to other communication transmissions. Harmonic suppression may include but not limited to the following:

(1) Installation of low-pass filters at the amateur/citizens band transmitter.

(2) Proper transmitter shielding.

(3) Proper transmitter tuning and loading.

(4) Use of antenna transmatches.

e. If television interference (TVI) and/or radio frequency interference (RFI) complaints are received by the command against an amateur/citizens band radio station they will cease operations immediately until the problem is corrected. Failure to do so could result in the permanent suspension of radio operating privileges aboard the Station.

f. The applicant will notify this Headquarters (Attn: Communication Data Electronics Officer) of any changes of information

contained in the original application as it occurs. Failure to do so will result in the suspension of the applicant's operating privileges aboard this Station.
