Subj: HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRAINING

1. Purpose. To provide implementing instructions for required training for personnel connected with transportation of hazardous materials.

2. Cancellation. StaO 4030.2B.

3. Background. References (a) and (b) require certification as to classification, description, packing, packaging, marking, and labeling of hazardous materials offered for shipment. References (c) and (d) require initial training and periodic refresher training for personnel authorized to certify hazardous materials for shipment by military and commercial aircraft (Military aircraft includes contractor services and those operated by the Air Mobility Command). Reference (d) cites mandatory training for personnel inspecting motor vehicles, cargo containers and rail cars to be used for shipment of hazardous materials. Reference (e) provides for Weapons personnel to inspect inbound shipments of arms, ammunition, explosives, and for Traffic Management personnel to inspect outbound shipments for compliance with all Department of Transportation, Department of Defense, state, and local regulations.

4. Action

a. Traffic Management Division and deploying squadrons will designate in writing personnel authorized to certify hazardous materials for shipment by military air.

b. Traffic Management Division and Weapons Division will designate in writing personnel authorized to inspect vehicles transporting hazardous materials.

c. Department Heads will be responsible for assuring compliance with references (a) through (f).

5. Summary of Revision. This order has been changed throughout and requires complete review.

6. Concurrence. The Commanding Officers of MAG-13, 1st LAAM Bn, MACS-7, MWSS-371, VMFT-401, MAWTS-1, and CSSD-16 concur in and make this Directive applicable to all 3rd and 4th MAW units located at MCAS Yuma.
